


## **Douglas County School District**

2012 was a busy year in Douglas County School District when it came to financial and transparency concerns. Key events include:

- High schools bore the brunt of budget cuts, despite the continued growth in fund balance.
- Annual parent and employee surveys show a troubling decline in the belief that the District is headed in a positive direction.
