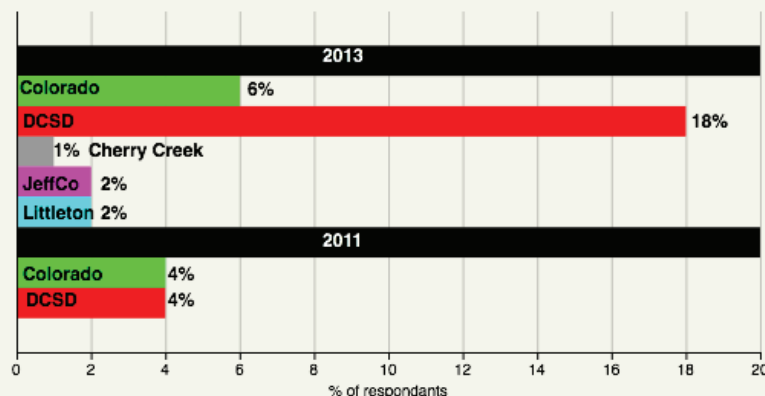

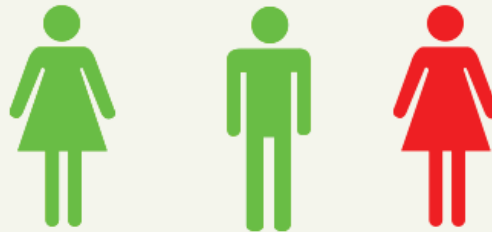

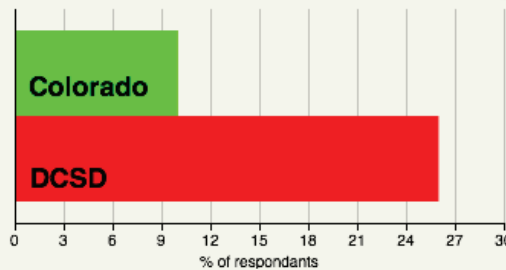
At the high school level in DCSD, on average, 1 in 3 teachers responded that their immediate professional development plan is to leave the district or to leave education.



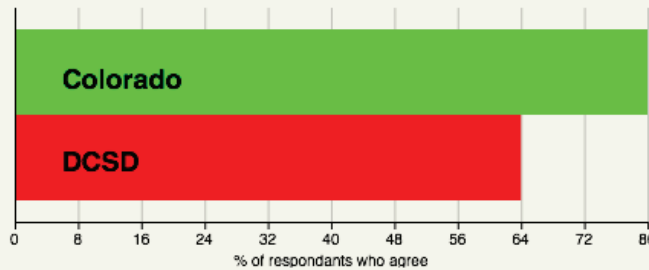

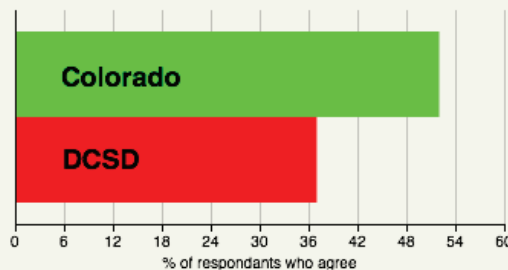
The new Evaluation System is the other area of concern which needs further investigation.
