This claim was true in 2009 for Reading, Writing and Math. It is no longer true in 2013.

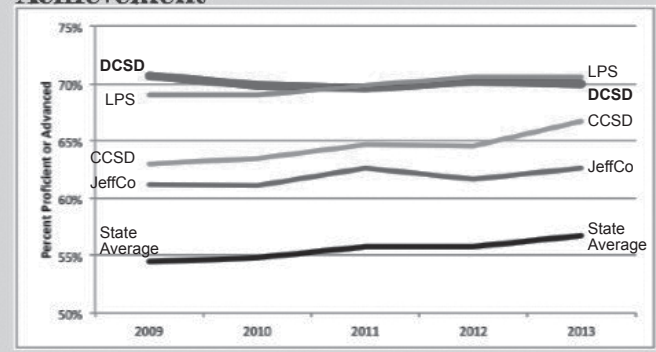


A closer look at Math results:

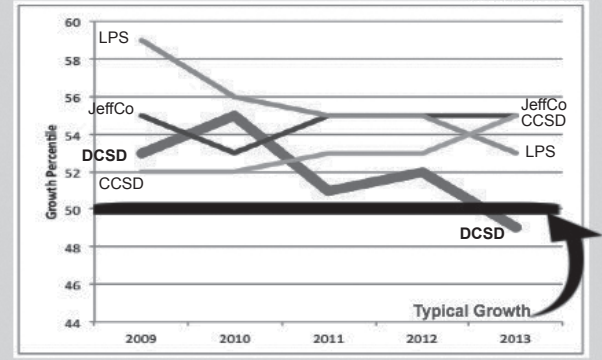
When compared to their academic peers, Individual Student Growth is declining and has dipped below typical growth for the state.
